On-The-Job Training

The On-The-Job Training (OJT) program is designed to assist employers who are not able to fill their labor force needs with currently skilled workers. Employers may use an OJT to hire new employees who qualify for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) funding which is administered through Employers' Training Resource.

EMPLOYERS SAVE TIME & MONEY ON THEIR HIRING AND TRAINING COSTS



Through this cost-saving program, employers can hire new qualified employees eligible through the Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act (WIOA). Reimbursement is provided to employers to pay for a portion of that employee's wages or salary during their training period.

Financial Hiring Incentives

Work Opportunity Tax Credits (WOTC)

Federal tax credits are available to employers who hire individuals qualifying as members of federally designated groups.

Enterprise Zone Tax Credits

Businesses located within specific boundaries are offered the opportunity to reduce their state business income tax liability through a variety of tax benefits.
