WIOA / EPIC Eligibility Requirements

- Must be between the ages of 18 to 24
- Resident of Kern County
- Must NOT be enrolled in secondary or post secondary education
- Must have right-to-work documents
- Be registered with the Selective Services (Males born after January 1, 1960)
- Must complete WIOA program application, a CASAS assessment, register for CaIJOBS, and complete an EPIC intake appointment for program eligibility
